
## **School Lunch Installation**

Macintosh OSX-Single User Setup Complete the following steps to install School Lunch on a Macintosh OSX computer.

- 1. Down load the latest version of School Lunch *from the Rodlan Down*loads Website. The download is in a .zip format.
- 2. Create a **School Lunch folder** in a location where you would like to locate the lunch program. *School Lunch* requires that the data file be located in the same folder as the executable. Many users choose to install on the desktop or on the hard drive.
- 3. Copy the unstuffed *School Lunch* 2012 to the **School Lunch folder** you created in step 2 above.





- 5. A copy of the *School Lunch* data file needs to be located in the **School Lunch folder** along side the *School Lunch 2012.exe* file as shown in the figure above. The first time you run the *School Lunch 2012* program you will be advised that you do not have a data file and the program will ask if you would like a data file to be created. If you are running *School Lunch* for the first time, choose to create a new data file. Quit the program and start the program again to have the *School Lunch* recognize the data file. If for some reason you are unable to create an empty data file, one can be downloaded from the download page.
- 6. If you are updating *School Lunch* from version 2011, simply copy the *SLD2011.rsd* file from your old program to the 2012 program folder you created above.
